GOVERNANCE REFORM ANNOUNCED

4 October 2019

The Archbishop announced the beginning of the consultation phase with Clergy of the Archdiocese.

REGIONAL CLERGY MEETINGS

22 October – 20 November 2019

Four Regional Governance Forums held to outline civil context and possible structures of governance arrangements. Sessions for gathering of concerns.

REGIONAL PRINCIPAL MEETINGS

11 – 28 November 2019

Four Regional Governance Forums held to outline civil context and possible structures of governance arrangements. Session for gathering of concerns.

SCHOOL GOVERNORS AND PRINCIPAL BRIEFING

8 October 2019

Acting Executive Director outlines schedule of four forums, first with clergy as governors, then four regional forums with primary and secondary principals.

STEERING COMMITTEE ANNOUNCED

30 October 2019

Comprised of representatives from the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne, parish priests, principals, parents and Catholic Education Melbourne.

INDEPENDENT CHAIR

Independent chair announces terms of reference to develop and steer the implementation process.
